(ii) Experience has been counted from the date of registration in the bar. (iii) Experience certificate obtained from the concerned court of practice or bar association or law firm or senior advocate or Government Department etc has been considered relevant towards legal practice. (iv) In the absence of particulars of professional registration in the online applications, the particulars if available in EC has been taken into consideration. (v) If experience certificate is not furnished, such applications are rejected as “Incomplete”. (vi) Mere possession of experience in handling court cases etc are not considered as legal experience if the post held by the candidate is not a legal post per se. (vii) Applications of candidates whose Experience Certificate does not specify the nature of duties have been rejected under the category of “Incomplete Applications” Appointment letters, resignation letters, pay certificates and the certificates attested by the candidates themselves or self employment certificates have not been considered as proof of experience and such applications are treated as “one without EC” and rejected under “Incomplete” category” Applications of candidates who have not submitted the requisite documents called for from them are also rejected under “Incomplete” category.
