<b>Modalities adopted</b>	(i) PS has been done on the basis of information furnished by the candidates in their applications.	

- (ii) Candidates with M.Sc in Physics followed by M.Tech. in Nano Science/Materials Engineering have been considered as per the criteria fixed above. Similarly M.Tech in Thermal Engineering/Production Engineering/Industrial Engineering/Manufacturing Engineering etc are treated relevant.
- (iii) Candidates who have not indicated in their applications the date of award of Ph. D degree were deemed to have submitted their thesis only and for the purpose of scrutiny such candidates were not treated as Ph. D holders.
- (iv) Experience in testing, Quality Assurance etc have been considered relevant under EQ-B. Accordingly, applications of only those candidates who have claimed experience in testing of Engineering Materials have been considered. Experience in Quality control has also been considered relevant while research experience and/or teaching experience which has no relevance to EQ-B have not been considered.
- (v) Experience Certificate are to be in prescribed Performa in terms of R(C&P)'s circular No. F.8/84/2010-R(C&P) dated 23.12.2010. However, wherever the applicants have not submitted experience certificates in prescribed Performa, their experience certificates have been considered on merit.
- (vi) Applications of candidates whose Experience Certificate does not specify the nature of duties have been rejected under the category of "Incomplete Applications". Appointment letters, resignation letters, pay certificates and the certificates attested by the candidates themselves or self employment certificates have not been considered as proof of experience and such applications are treated as "one without EC" and rejected under "Incomplete" category". Applications of candidates who have not submitted the requisite documents called for from them are also rejected under "Incomplete" category.
- (vii) If the experience certificate submitted is old, experience in counted only upto the date of issue, even if a higher claim is made in the online application.
- (viii) Some of the candidates can be rejected under more than one category. They have been rejected under the most
